UNPA would like to advise collectors that in Bulletin No. 117, the euro value of the HeForShe stamps was incorrectly stated as € 1,70 instead of the correct value of € 0,80. Furthermore, the marginal inscription for the € 0,80 value of the HeForShe stamp is incorrectly printed.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION—THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

UNITED NATIONS STAMPS USED FOR MAILING

United Nations stamps in United States dollar denominations are valid for postage only if mailed at United Nations Headquarters in New York. Stamps in Swiss franc denominations are valid for postage only if mailed at the Palais des Nations, Geneva, Switzerland. Stamps in euro denominations are valid for postage only if mailed at the Vienna International Centre, Austria.

PRICES

Stamps are sold at face value. UN/Geneva and UN/Vienna stamps are sold at USD equivalent rates, rounded up to the nearest cent. The USD equivalents of the euro and Swiss franc denomination stamps are subject to fluctuating exchange rates.

SALES AND EXCHANGES

Every effort is made to provide UNPA customers with materials of the highest philatelic quality. Therefore, all sales are final and no exchange or refund will be made except where stamps are received in damaged condition.

CHANGE IN UNPA FIRST DAY COVERS SELLING PERIOD

Please be advised that there will be a change in policy regarding the selling period of UNPA first day covers. Effective 2 September 2014, the selling period changed from three months to six months.

REGISTRATION THRESHOLD

UNPA changed the registration threshold amount effective 15 July 2014. Orders valued at \$200.00 and above are automatically registered.

The next column asks for a description of each item as a cross reference. In this space, you may also indicate any specific requests, e.g., special marginal inscription (M.I.) positions. Total your order and indicate whether registration of the order is requested. Add postage and handling charges. Enclose your remittance and mail to the indicated address.

INTERNATIONAL DANCE DAY

On 29 April 2016, International Dance Day is celebrated all over the world, as dancers rejoice and share their passions and creativity with millions of people. The day brings together international, national and local organizations, as well as select individuals active in dance, both amateurs and professionals.

In 1982, the International Theatre Institute (ITI), a partner of UNESCO (the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization) founded International Dance Day to be celebrated every year on 29 April on the anniversary of the birthdate of Jean-Georges Noverre (1727-1810), the creator of modern ballet. The purpose of the International Dance Day is to celebrate Dance, to rejoice in the universality of the art form, to cross all political, cultural and ethnic barriers and

bring people together with a common language—Dance. The International Dance Council (CID), another partner of UNESCO, also supports and promotes the art of dance worldwide.

Dance is a universal language; Dance is a passport; Dance opens the door to other countries, other peoples, other cultures. Dance promotes freedom, understanding, friendship, tolerance.

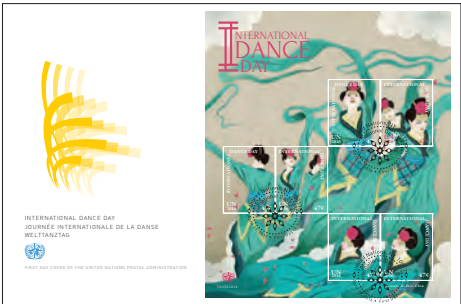
Dance is the most direct and effective means to implement the ideals of democratic society: freedom of expression, equality of rights, no discrimination.

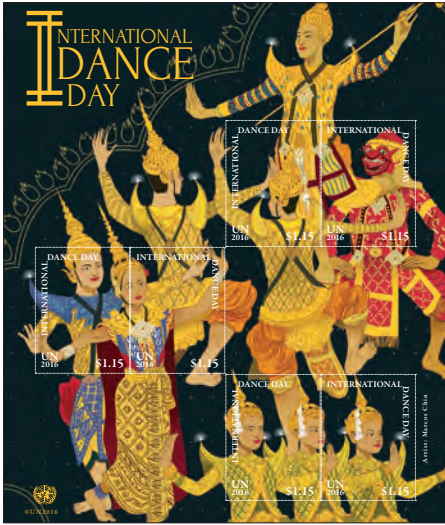

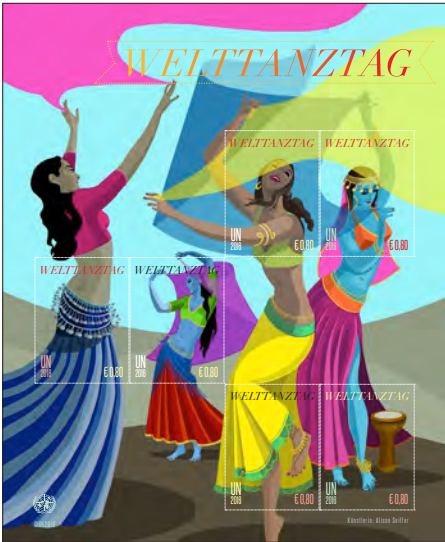

INTERNATIONAL DAY OF UN PEACEKEEPERS

The International Day of United Nations Peacekeepers was established by the General Assembly in 2002 in tribute to all the men and women serving in peacekeeping operations for their high level of professionalism, dedication and courage and to honour the memory of those who have lost their lives in the cause of peace. The Assembly designated 29 May as the Day because it was the date in 1948 when the United Nations Truce Supervision Organization (UNTSO), the world body's first peacekeeping mission, began operations in Palestine.

Since the first UN peacekeeping mission was established in 1948, thousands of police and civilian personnel have lost their lives in the service of peace as a result of acts of violence, accidents and disease. On 29 May, UN offices, alongside Member States and non-governmental organizations, hold solemn events to honour fallen peacekeepers. At the UN Headquarters in New York, the Secretary-General presides over a wreath-laying ceremony in honour of all peacekeepers who lost their lives while serving under the UN flag. In addition, the Dag Hammarskjöld Medal is awarded

posthumously to the peacekeepers who have fallen while serving in the cause of peace, during the preceding year. Since the establishment of UNTSO, the first peacekeeping mission in May 1948, we have lost over 3,000 Peacekeepers.

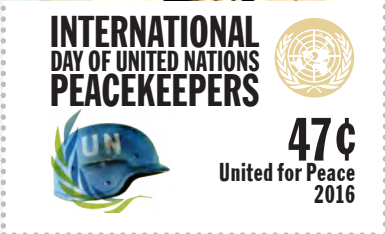
UN peacekeeping operations use the Day to strengthen bonds with the local populations that they have been deployed to serve. For example, they may hold sporting events, school and orphanage visits, art and essay competitions, photo exhibits, neighbourhood clean-ups, tree plantings, concerts, and conferences and workshops on peace issues.

On this day, we continue to honour the memory of those who gave their lives to the cause of peace, and pay tribute to all men and women who carry on their legacy by serving in the field.

UNPA is proud to issue stamps that feature images of the important work of UN peacekeepers around the world. The stamps will be part of a joint stamp issuance with Austrian Post at the World Stamp Show in New York with a pre-launch ceremony on 28 May.

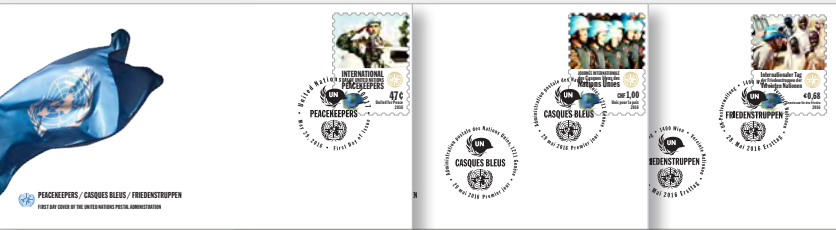

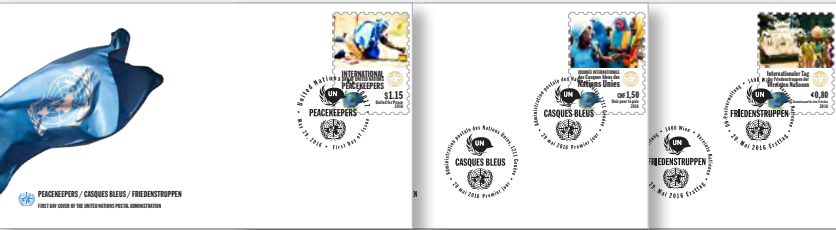

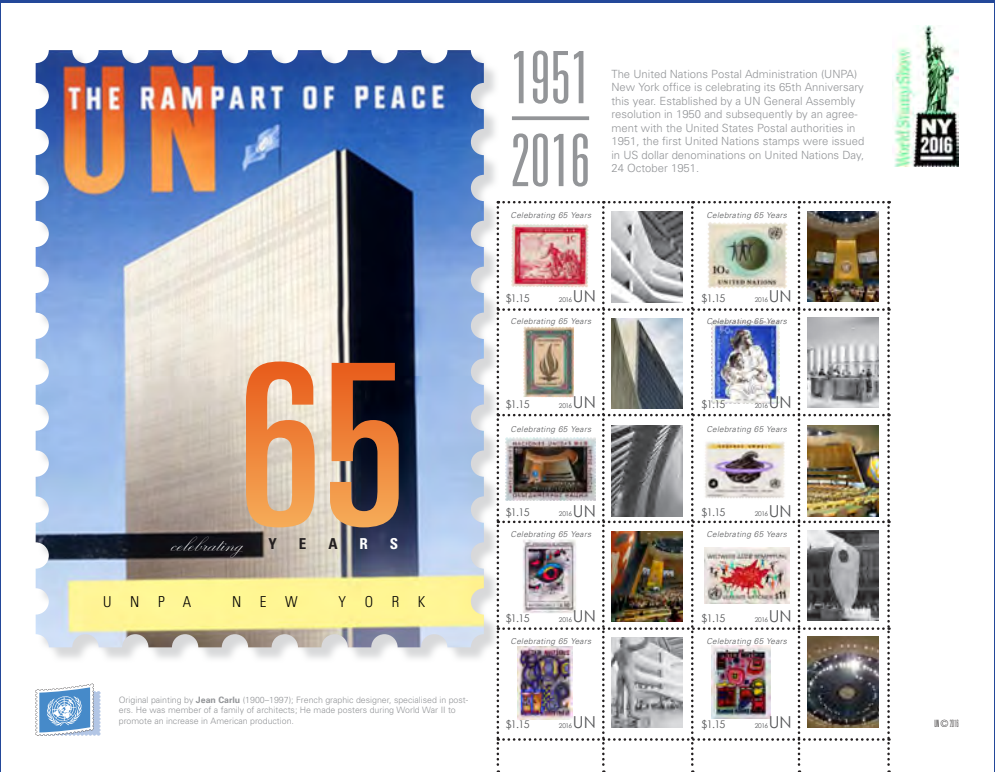
