LETTER FROM THE CHIEF

Dear Collectors,

We had a very successful World Stamp Show in New York City this May/June, and we thank you all of the participants that have visited our booth and first day of issue ceremonies. We are particularly excited to see many of you and learnt of your relentless support of the UNPA stamp programmes.

For this summer, UNPA will issue a new set of stamps "Sport for Peace" to promote the message of the Olympic Truce for the 2016 Summer Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. UNPA is working closely with the International Olympic Committee and the UN Office on Sport for Development and Peace to develop and issue these new colourful Olympic stamps. The artist Nick Iluzada has done a wonderful job illustrating some of the most popular sporting events at the Olympics.

In September, the UNPA will continue its very popular World Heritage stamp series, featuring sites in the Czech Republic. This will be our first joint stamp issue with the Czech Post, and there will be a special first day of issue ceremony in Prague to launch these stamps. The stamps, along with the beautifully designed prestige booklet, tell about the rich history of this amazing country.

UNPA is also pleased to announce the introduction of a new type of special event sheet which will be issued on 10 August for the 32nd Asian International Stamp Exhibition (AISE) in Bangkok, Thailand. This special event "mini-sheet" will contain three stamps, and UNPA plans to use this new format to issue a special event sheet in conjunction with various stamp exhibits that UNPA will attend in the future. The first issue for the 32nd AISE, the new mini-sheet will contain stamps denominated in US dollars, Swiss Francs and Euros. This is possibly the first stamp sheet in the market issued with three currencies on them.

I value your interest in the UNPA stamp programme and look forward to developing new and exciting stamps for you. As always, we welcome your comments and suggestions.

n 22 July 2016, the UN Postal Administration will issue a set of stamps to promote the contribution of sport to peace. The date of issue comes exactly a week ahead of the start of the Olympic Truce period for this year's 2016 Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

Based on the ancient Greek tradition of ekecheiria which calls for a truce during the Olympic Games to encourage a peaceful environment and ensure safe passage, in 1993 the United Nations revived this ideal by passing General Assembly Resolutions in every Olympic year to urge Member States to respect the Olympic Truce. Through its most recent resolution in October 2015, the General Assembly called on Member States to observe the Truce from the seventh day before the start of the XXXI Olympic Summer Games until the seventh day following the end of the XV Paralympic Summer Games in Rio de Janeiro.

UNPA has partnered with the International Olympic Committee and the UN Office on Sport for Development and Peace to develop and issue these colorful stamps which feature several Olympic sports.

The Olympic movement inspires people to contribute to a peaceful future for humankind through the educational value of sport. It brings together athletes from all parts of the world for the Olympic Games. One of the objectives of this great international sporting event is to promote peace, respect, mutual understanding and goodwill, goals it shares with the United Nations.

The artist

Nick Iluzada (USA) is an illustrator, designer, and cheap eats enthusiast living in Los Angeles, California. When not sketch-booking, he can be found neck-deep in soccer-related activities. His clients include Apple, Google, Major League Soccer, The New York Times, and Wired. These are his first stamp designs for the United Nations.

US\$ 0.47 - Historic Centre of Prague

Prague is one of the most beautiful cities in Europe in terms of its setting on both banks of the Vltava River, adorned with its distinctive townscape of houses, palaces with towers, and buildings. Built between the 11th and 18th centuries, the Old Town, the Lesser Town and the New Town speak of the great architectural and cultural influence enjoyed by this city since the Middle Ages. The site was inscribed on the World Heritage list in 1992.

€ 0.68 – Kutná Hora: Historical Town Centre with the Church of St. Barbara and the Cathedral of Our Lady at Sedlec

From the early 14th century to the early 16th century, Kutná Hora was the second most important town in the Kingdom of Bohemia after Prague. This is still apparent in the town's exceptional wealth of historical architecture. This site was inscribed on the World Heritage list in 1995 as an outstanding example of the medieval town whose wealth and prosperity was based on its silver mines. The Church of St. Barbara and other buildings were underlined as having particular architectural and artistic quality and as having had a profound influence on subsequent developments in the architecture of Central Europe.

CHF 1.50 – Lednice-Valtice Cultural Landscape

Between the 17th and 20th centuries, the ruling dukes of Liechtenstein transformed their territories in southern Moravia into a striking landscape. It combined Baroque architecture (mainly the work of Johann Bernhard Fischer von Erlach) and the classical and neo-Gothic styles of the castles of Lednice and Valtice with countryside fashioned according to English romantic principles of landscape architecture. At 200 km², it is one of the largest artificial landscapes in Europe. It was inscribed on the World Heritage list in 1996.

The Designs

US\$ 1.15 - Holy Trinity Column in Olomouc

The Olomouc Holy Trinity Column is one of the most exceptional examples of the pinnacle of central European Baroque artistic expression. This memorial column, erected in the early years of the 18th century, is the most outstanding example of a type of monument specific to central Europe. Rising to a height of 35 metres, it is decorated with many fine religious sculptures, which are the work of the distinguished Moravian artist Ondrej Zahner. It was inscribed on the World Heritage list in 2000.

€ 1.70 - Historic Centre of Český Krumlov

The historic centre of Český Krumlov is situated on the banks of the Vltava river, which provides a natural setting of great beauty. The town was built around a 13th-century castle belonging to a member of the ruling Vitkovici family. This historic centre is an outstanding example of a small central European medieval town whose architectural heritage has remained relatively intact thanks to its peaceful history over more than five centuries. It was inscribed on the World Heritage list in 1992.

CHF 1.00 – Gardens and Castle at Kroměříž

The Gardens and Castle at Kroměříž are an exceptionally complete and well preserved example of a European Baroque princely residence and its associated landscape of the 17th and 18th centuries. The ensemble at Kroměříž, played a significant role in the development of Baroque garden and palace design in central Europe. It was inscribed on the World Heritage list in 1998.






