# 2020 ENDANGERED SPECIES

On 17 February 2020, UNPA will issue its 2020 Endangered Species stamps, which focus on the plight of migratory species. For this year's series, UNPA has partnered with both the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) as well as the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species (CMS) to help raise awareness about the plight of these endangered animals.

The stamps will be issued in conjunction with the thirteenth session of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals (CMS COP13), which will be held from 15–22 February 2020 in Gandhinagar, India. The theme for the conference is "Migratory species connect the planet and together we welcome them home".

## 2020 CHINESE LUNAR CALENDAR - YEAR OF THE RAT NEW YORK SPECIAL EVENT SHEET US\$1.20

On 10 January 2020, UNPA continues its Chinese Lunar Calendar series with the issuance of a special event sheet celebrating the Year of the Rat. This is the eleventh sheet issued for UNPA's Lunar New Year stamp series. The sheet is composed of 10 US\$1.20 denominated stamps with the United Nations logo. The tabs of the stamps and background design feature artwork designed by Yin Huili (China).

The Year of the Rat is the first sign in the Chinese zodiac cycle. According to myth, the Jade Emperor said the order of the animals would be decided by the order in which they arrived at his party. The rat tricked the ox into giving him a ride. Then, just as they arrived at the door, the rat jumped down and landed ahead of the ox, becoming the first to arrive.

The rat is the Chinese zodiac sign known for being inquisitive, shrewd and resourceful. In Chinese culture, rats are a sign of wealth and surplus. Rats are clever, quick thinkers. They are successful, but content with living a quiet and peaceful life. Since the rat is the first in the rotation of the 12 zodiac signs, the Year of the Rat is considered a year of new beginnings and renewal. When the Rat year comes, it generally delivers new experiences with favourable outcomes for all of the zodiac signs.

## HELLO KITTY AND GLOBAL GOALS

On 19 March 2020, UNPA will issue a set of six mini-sheets featuring Hello Kitty and the Global Goals, also known as the Sustainable Development Goals. The self-adhesive stamps are blank with several Hello Kitty elements in the tab, which can be incorporated on the stamps, creating their own personal designs.

The United Nations and Sanrio Co., Ltd. launched a strategic collaboration to promote the Sustainable Development Goals. Through the collaboration, Hello Kitty highlights six of the 17 Goals introducing them through the #HelloGlobalGoals global video series.

The six SDGs featured on the UN stamps are as follows: Goal 3 – Good Health and Well-Being; Goal 4 – Quality Education; Goal 5 – Gender Equality; Goal 11 – Sustainable Cities and Communities; Goal 13 – Climate Action; and Goal 14 – Life Below Water.

"Hello Kitty is bringing her enormous fanbase to our global efforts to educate young people, in every part of our world, about the Sustainable Development Goals, and why they should be involved in achieving them," said Melissa Fleming, Under-Secretary-General for Global Communications, United Nations.

Three accordion booklets, which contain six different stamp sheets, will accompany the stamp series.
