

THE UNPA STAMP COUNTERS AT THE VIENNA INTERNATIONAL CENTRE AND THE PALAIS DES NATIONS GENEVA ARE NOW OPEN TO VISITORS!

As of 10 January 2022, the United Nations Postal Administration's stamp counter in the Vienna International Centre is open for business. Visitors can purchase United Nations stamps and post their UN-stamped mail from Monday to Friday between 11:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

As of 10 January 2022, the United Nations Postal Administration's stamp counter in Geneva is open for business too. Visitors may come to the counter from Monday to Friday between 11 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Looking back at our programme of the past year, we have had many interesting and important stamp issues, which included United Against Racism and Discrimination; Olympic Games in Tokyo; Mother Teresa; and World Toilet Day.

In addition, UNPA issued several special event sheets to mark the twenty-fifth anniversary of the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty, the Dubai Expo, United Nations Biodiversity Conference, the "Celebrations" stamp sheets and the seventy-fifth anniversary of the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF). In addition, UNPA will feature Intangible Cultural Heritage for its World Heritage stamp series, Endangered Species stamps, the second set of Crypto stamps and a number of special event sheets.

JOHN LENNON - FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY "IMAGINE" INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PEACE

On 21 September each year, the International Day of Peace is observed around the world. The United Nations has declared it as a day devoted to strengthening the ideals of peace, both within and among all nations and peoples. It is an occasion for all of humanity to put aside their differences and contribute to promoting a culture of peace worldwide.

The United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA) is marking this occasion with the issuance of three stamps featuring the world-renowned musician John Lennon. The special souvenir sheets contain the song lyrics of "Imagine", John Lennon's signature and his self-portrait.


The year 2021 marks the fiftieth anniversary of the recording of "Imagine" by the English rock musician. Released in 1971, the song, which is the most successful single of Lennon's solo career, has been covered by artists in every genre around the globe. It has been performed at some of the world's biggest events, including concerts for peace, hunger, New Year's celebrations and the Olympic Games. It has also been played as a hopeful message during troubling times throughout history.

The song lyrics encourage us to put aside all differences and unify to imagine a world of peace, without greed, without hunger, without barriers separating people and nations. John Lennon's message of peace, love and goodwill conveyed through his music, still resonates today.

We can best honour the International Day of Peace by standing up against acts of hate and by spreading compassion, kindness and hope so the world can "live as one" – just as John Lennon imagined.


The stamps and souvenir sheets feature photographs by Bob Gruen (US\$ value), Iain Macmillan (CHF value) and David Nutter (Euro value). The stamps were illustrated by Martin Mörck (Norway) based on the photographs. The stamp issue was designed by Rorie Katz. (United Nations).

DUBAI EXPO 2020SPECIAL EVENT MINI-SHEET

On 1 October 2021, UNPA issued a special event three-stamp mini-sheet in the denominations of \$1.30, CHF 2,00 and €1,80 to commemorate the Dubai Expo 2020 in the United Arab Emirates. The Dubai Expo runs from 1 October 2021 through 31 March 2022. It was postponed in 2020 owing to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The theme for the Expo is "Connecting Minds, Creating the Future", which aims to inspire people to initiate change with a focus on sustainability, opportunity and mobility. The United Nations is joining nearly 200 pavilions and participants globally to collaborate and innovate for a better and more sustainable world. The Opportunity Pavilion is home to the United Nations Hub – #UNHub – where the United Nations will feature the impactful work of the Organization, highlight international days, promote support for the Sustainable Development Goals and much more.

According to Maher Nasser, the Commissioner-General for the United Nations at the Expo, the Organization's presence will inform, inspire and engage visitors to take action towards a thriving future for people and planet.

The stamps and background of the sheet features images of the pavilions at the Expo. They were designed by Sergio Baradat (United Nations).

A quantity of 15,000 sheets were printed by Cartor Security Printing (France). The stamp sheets are consecutively numbered.

UNITED NATIONS BIODIVERSITY CONFERENCE

On 11 October 2021, UNPA issued a special event three-stamp mini-sheet in the denominations of \$1.30, CHF 2,00 and €1,80 to commemorate the United Nations Biodiversity Conference. The first part of the meeting will take place virtually from 11 to 15 October 2021, with the second part reconvening face-to-face from 25 April to 8 May 2022 in Kunming, China. The conference was postponed in 2020 owing to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Biological diversity is about more than plants, animals, fungi and microorganisms and their ecosystems. It is about people and our need for food security, medicines, fresh air and water, shelter, and a clean and healthy environment in which to live.

Despite ongoing efforts, biodiversity is deteriorating worldwide. The United Nations Biodiversity Conference will convene

governments from around the world to agree on a new set of goals for nature over the next decade through the Convention on Biological Diversity. This post-2020 global biodiversity framework sets out an ambitious plan to implement action to bring about a transformation in society's relationship with biodiversity and to ensure that, by 2050, the shared vision of living in harmony with nature is fulfilled.

The stamp sheet incorporates coral fish, ants, tiger, snake, orchid, beetle, crane bird, salamander, turtle, volcanic coral and fossil. The sheets are consecutively numbered, making each one unique.

The stamp sheet incorporates vertebrates, invertebrates, mammals, amphibians, reptiles, birds, fish, plants and microorganisms. It was designed by Sergio Baradat (United Nations).





2021 ANNUAL COLLECTION FOLDER





World Toilet Day is observed annually on 19 November to raise awareness of the 4.2 billion people living without access to safely managed sanitation, which undermines health, dignity and economic development. It is a day for taking action to tackle the global sanitation crisis and to achieve Sustainable Development Goal 6: water and sanitation for all by 2030.

The effects of climate change, such as floods, droughts and rising sea levels are threatening sanitation systems – from toilets to septic tanks to treatment plants. Floodwater can damage toilets and contaminate drinking water, which spreads human waste into our communities and food crops, causing deadly and chronic diseases. These incidents, which are becoming more frequent as climate change worsens, cause public health emergencies and degrade the environment.

Globally, 80 per cent of the wastewater generated by society flows back into the ecosystem without being treated or reused. Sustainable sanitation systems make productive use of waste to safely boost agriculture and reduce and capture emissions for greener energy.

Everyone has a right to safe, clean sanitation and drinking water. It is critical that we all have access to sustainable sanitation, clean water

and hygiene facilities to maintain healthy communities and to help stop the spread of deadly infectious diseases, such as COVID-19 and other illnesses.

THE DESIGNS:

The United Nations stamps created for World Toilet Day 2021 depict three of the most important ways toilets, water and hygiene add value to our lives.

Safely managed toilets and water services dispose of our waste, helping prevent food crops from being contaminated and ensuring sustainable use of water in agriculture.

CHF 1,00 Good hygiene practices are possible only with reliable and affordable water and sanitation services, which help to protect people from preventable diseases such as COVID-19 and cholera.

€1,00 Toilets at home, school and workplaces particularly benefit women and girls, helping them play their full role in society, especially during menstruation and pregnancy.

UNPA at the 75th Salon Philatélique d'Automne in Paris

From 4 to 7 November 2021, the United Nations Postal Administration will be represented at the 75th Salon Philatélique d'Automne (Autumn Philatelic Fair). The salon will take place at the "Espace Champerret" in Paris (75017), France, where we will be offering a white card and an exhibition cachet. Opening hours are Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Admission is free!

The imprint on the white card shows a map of France with two cyclists to represent the best known and most famous bicycle race in the world. The Tour de France or Grande Boucle is an annual competition bicycle race primarily held in France, while also occasionally passing through nearby European countries, like the other Grand Tours (the Giro d'Italia and the Vuelta a España).

The show cachet features a bicycle helmet, the United Nations emblem, as well as the logo of the show. Both designs were created by Austrian artist Prof. Hannes Margreiter.



Please note that the show card for Paris 2021 can only be ordered online or with the order form 1/2022, which will be included in the next philatelic journal Fascination.
