



2023 CHINESE LUNAR CALENDAR – YEAR OF THE RABBIT NEW YORK SPECIAL EVENT SHEET – \$1.40

On 20 January 2023, UNPA celebrates the Chinese Lunar Calendar – Year of the Rabbit with the issuance of a special event sheet of ten stamps.

The Chinese New Year officially begins on 22 January 2023 and ends 9 February 2024. The Rabbit is the fourth animal sign in the Chinese zodiac cycle.

For this year, UNPA is continuing its new sheet design and format, which started in 2022. The ten US\$1.40 denominated stamps feature the illustration of a Rabbit, and the tabs to the left of the stamps bear a white United Nations logo with a background in gold.

The stamps and the sheet's background were illustrated by Tiger Pan (China), who also illustrated the Chinese Lunar Calendar - Year of the Tiger stamps in 2022 as well as the Chinese Lunar Calendar - Year of the Dog stamps in 2018.

A special Year of the Rabbit postcard, featuring the same illustration as the stamps, is also being issued.

The stamp sheet may be personalized with a photograph in place of the UN logo. Customers can either visit the UNPA stamp shops in New York, Geneva or Vienna or upload their photos to the UNPA website: unstamps.org

ENDANGERED SPECIES - FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF CITES

On 3 March 2023, UNPA continues its Endangered Species stamp series with the issuance of 12 stamps.

This year, the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) celebrates its fiftieth anniversary. To mark this occasion, UNPA is featuring species of flora and fauna for which there have been conservation success stories.

CITES is an international agreement between Governments that sets rules for international trade in wildlife. The Convention regulates international trade in more than 38,000 species of wild animals and plants. Its purpose is to ensure that this trade is legal, sustainable and traceable, and to ensure that international trade in specimens of wild animals and plants does not threaten their survival.

For more than 25 years, UNPA has issued stamps in support of CITES to celebrate the many beautiful and varied forms of wild fauna and flora and to raise awareness of the multitude of benefits that conservation provides to people.





The artist

Rlon Wang (王荣亮) was born in Tianshui, Gansu province, China, in 1985. He graduated from Tianshui Normal University, Department of Fine Arts, where he majored in Chinese painting. Rlon now lives and works in Shenzhen, Guangdong province, and is well known as an illustrator and designer. He works with rich colours, making his style visually impactful. Since he became an independent illustrator in 2014, Rlon's commercial work has been highly praised.








ENDANGERED SPECIES FOLDER







The category of least developed countries (LDCs) was established by the General Assembly for the purpose of attracting special international support for the most vulnerable and disadvantaged members of the United Nations family.

The current list of LDCs includes 46 countries representing 33 in Africa, 13 in Asia and the Pacific and 1 in Latin America. Over 1 billion people live in these countries – about 13 per cent of world population – but their economies account for less than 2 per cent of world GDP and less than 1 per cent of global trade.

The mission of the Office of the High Representative for Least Developed Countries, Landlocked Developing Countries and Small Island Developing States (OHRLLS) is to raise awareness about the economic, social and environmental potential that exist in these countries and to ensure that the pressing needs of the 1.1 billion people who live in them, remain high on the international agenda.

The Fifth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries (LDC5) will be held in Doha, Qatar in March 2023, putting the needs of the most vulnerable people back into focus. Investment in these young, vibrant countries can help drive sustainable growth for generations.

The stamp sheets are consecutively numbered 1 through 16,000, so each one is unique. The sheet was designed by OHRLLS.
