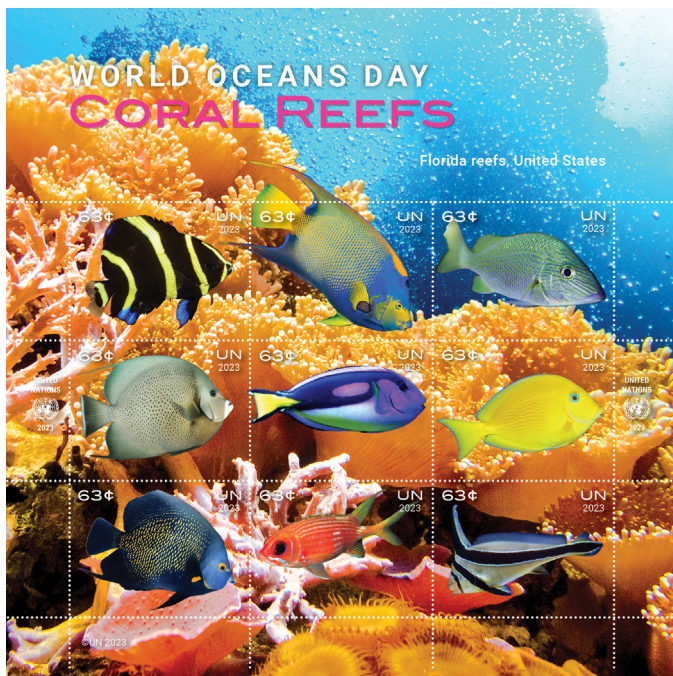

WORLD OCEANS DAY CORAL REEFS

On 8 June 2023, the United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA) will issue new stamps to celebrate World Oceans Day – focusing on coral reefs. The United Nations recognizes World Oceans Day every year on 8 June to celebrate the world's shared ocean and our personal connection to the sea, as well as to raise global awareness surrounding the crucial role the ocean plays in our lives and the important ways people can help protect it.

The theme for World Oceans Day 2023 is "Planet Ocean: Tides are Changing". The ocean covers the majority of the earth, but only a small portion of its waters has been explored. Despite humanity's utter reliance on it and compared to the breadth and depth of what it gives us, the ocean receives only a fragment of our attention and resources in return.

Oceans feed us, regulate our climate, and generate most of the oxygen we breathe. They also serve as the foundation for much of the world's economy, supporting sectors from tourism to fisheries to international shipping.

However, despite their importance, oceans are facing unprecedented threats as a result of human activity. Every year, an estimated 8 million tons of plastic waste end up in the world's oceans. At the same time, climate change is damaging coral reefs and other key ecosystems; overfishing is threatening the stability of fish stocks; nutrient pollution is contributing to the creation of dead zones; and nearly 80 per cent of the world's wastewater is discharged without treatment.

Coral reefs are well known as some of the most beautiful, biologically diverse and delicate ecosystems in the world. They are also vital to maintaining food supply and protecting the shoreline of low-lying island nations. Nevertheless, the United Nations Environment Programme estimates that about 25 to 50 per cent of the world's coral reefs have been destroyed and another 60 per cent are under threat.

DON'T CHOOSE EXTINCTION FRANKIE THE DINOSAUR URGES WORLD LEADERS TO TAKE ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

UNPA is issuing three new stamps on 20 June 2023 in support of the Don't Choose Extinction campaign, which was launched by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in 2021 for the COP26 UN Climate Summit. The campaign calls for an end to fossil fuels and a global transition towards sustainable, green economies.

At the heart of the campaign is a short film launched by UNDP featuring an animated dinosaur named Frankie (voiced by actor Jack Black), who storms up to the General Assembly podium at United Nations Headquarters in New York, shocking diplomats and urging world leaders to take action before it is too late. Frankie the Dino calls out Governments for spending billions on fossil fuel subsidies.

The three stamp sheets feature Frankie the Dino in the General Assembly Hall.

Each sheet has a QR code that when scanned will launch the full video about Frankie addressing world leaders to take action against climate change.

Climate change refers to long-term shifts in temperatures and weather patterns, mainly caused by human activities, particularly the burning of fossil fuels. The consequences of climate change are far-reaching and include, extreme weather, intense droughts, water scarcity, severe fires, rising sea levels, flooding, melting polar ice, catastrophic storms and declining biodiversity.

UNDP research, released as part of the campaign, shows that the world spends \$423 billion annually just to subsidize fossil fuels – nearly three times the annual amount needed to eradicate extreme global poverty.

Frankie ends his speech by declaring to the audience: *"It's time for you humans to stop making excuses and start making changes. Don't Choose Extinction!"*

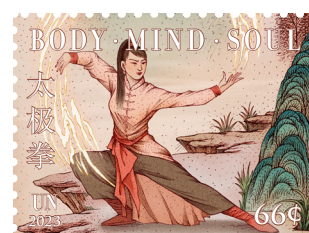
On 10 August 2023, UNPA will issue three stamps and three souvenir sheets on the theme, Body, Mind and Soul. When body, mind and soul are in harmony, one experiences good health, inner peace and happiness. The stamps represent three UNESCO intangible cultural heritage from China that contribute to these qualities – the practices of Taijiquan, Calligraphy and Guqin and its music.

66¢ STAMP AND \$1.50 SOUVENIR SHEET – TAIJIQUAN

Taijiquan is a traditional physical practice characterized by relaxed, circular movements that works in concert with breath regulation and the cultivation of a righteous and neutral mind. Originating during the mid-seventeenth century in Wenxian County in the Henan Province of central China, the element is now practised throughout the country by people of all ages and by different ethnic groups.

Taijiquan's basic movements centre upon wubu (five steps) and bafa (eight techniques) with a series of routines, exercises and tuishou (hand-pushing skills performed with a counterpart). The element builds upon the yin and yang cycle and the cultural understanding of the unity of heaven and humanity.

Taijiquan was inscribed on the UNESCO Representative List of the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in 2020.

CHF 1,10 STAMP AND CHF 2,30 SOUVENIR SHEET – CHINESE CALLIGRAPHY

Chinese calligraphy, which is the art of drawing Chinese characters, combines purely visual art and interpretation of the literary meaning. Calligraphy established itself as the most important ancient Chinese art form, alongside painting, first coming to the fore during the Han dynasty (206 BCE–220 CE).

Whether they are recording information or simply creating beautiful forms, calligraphers' brushes are used to ink five distinctive styles of script, known as "seal", "official", "cursive", "running" and "regular". The art may appear on any writing surface, but it is especially common on letters, scrolls, works of literature and fan coverings.

Calligraphy offers an important channel for the appreciation of traditional culture and for arts education. It is also a source of pride and pleasure for the Chinese people and embodies important aspects of the country's intellectual and artistic heritage.

Chinese calligraphy was inscribed on the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in 2009.

€1,00 STAMP AND €1,90 SOUVENIR SHEET - GUQIN AND ITS MUSIC

The Chinese zither, called *guqin*, has existed for over 3,000 years and represents China's foremost solo musical instrument tradition. The *guqin* was one of the four arts – along with calligraphy, painting and an ancient form of chess – that Chinese scholars were expected to master. According to tradition, 20 years of training was required to attain proficiency.

The *guqin* has seven strings and 13 marked pitch positions. By attaching the strings in 10 different ways, players can obtain a range of four octaves. The three basic playing techniques are known as san (open string), an (stopped string) and fan (harmonics).

Nowadays, there are fewer than one thousand well-trained *guqin* players and perhaps no more than 50 surviving masters. The original repertory of several thousand compositions has drastically dwindled to a mere hundred works that are regularly performed today.

Guqin practice was inscribed on the Representative List of the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in 2008.

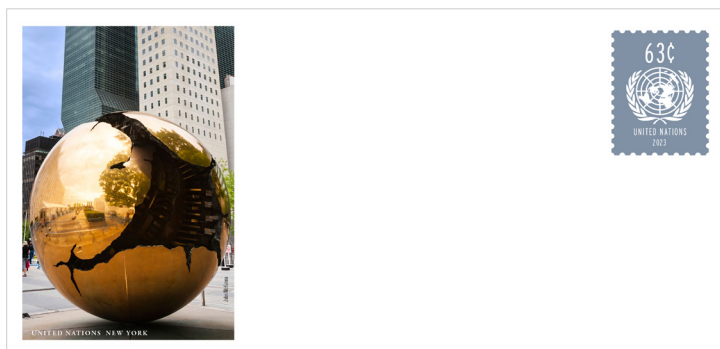
The new 63¢ envelope represents Sphere Within Sphere sculpture by Arnaldo Pomodoro at United Nations Headquarters in New York City.

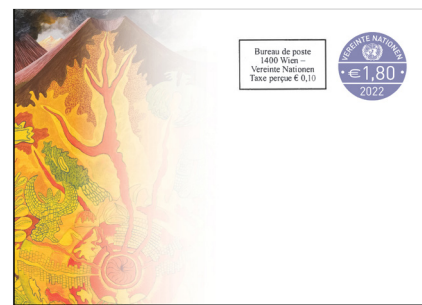

INTERNATIONAL TEA DAY GENEVA SPECIAL EVENT SHEET

UNPA will issue a sheet of 10 stamps in the denomination of CHF 1,10 on 21 May 2023 to celebrate International Tea Day. The stamps feature tea, tea pots and tea ceremonies from various countries around the world. The tabs of the stamps feature the United Nations logo.

International Tea Day is observed annually on 21 May, to raise awareness of the long history and the deep cultural and economic significance of tea around the world. The goal of the day, which was adopted by the General Assembly in 2019, is to encourage collective actions to implement activities in favour of the sustainable production and consumption of tea and raise awareness of its importance in fighting hunger and poverty.

Tea is the world's most consumed drink, after water. It has been with us for a long time. There is evidence that tea was consumed in China 5,000 years ago. Tea consumption can bring health benefits and wellness due to the beverage's anti-inflammatory, antioxidant and weight-loss effects. It also has cultural and economic significance in many societies.

Tea production and processing relates to the Sustainable Development Goals as it contributes to the reduction of extreme poverty (Goal 1); the fight against hunger (Goal 2); the empowerment of women (Goal 5); and the sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems (Goal 15).

The stamp sheets may be personalized with a photograph in place of the United Nations logo. Customers can either visit the UNPA stamp shops in New York or Vienna or upload their photos to the UNPA website – unstamps.org.

Customers with standing order requirements for special event sheets will automatically receive this item through their accounts. All other customers can purchase this special event sheet in either mint or cancelled condition by using the order form attached to this *Bulletin*.

UNPA PERSONALIZED/CUSTOMIZED STAMP PROGRAMME

The UNPA has revived and made some changes to its personalized/customized stamp programme for 2023. A new stamp sheet format has been added, where all the 10 stamp designs and denominations are fixed, but all the rest of the non-stamp area can be customized. This will give the United Nations agencies and Member States the opportunity to celebrate anniversaries and achievements using the same United Nations stamps.

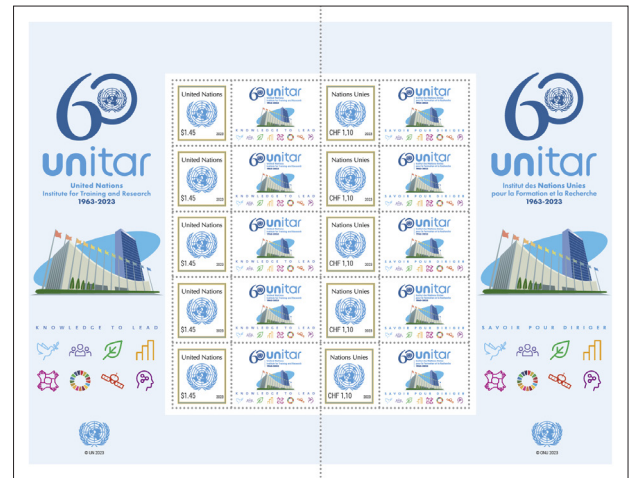
This new custom stamp sheet format will be incorporated and introduced in UNPA's programme of issue in November 2023 as a special event sheet for the United Nations Climate Change Conference. The same stamp sheet format and United Nations stamps have been used for the celebration of the Seventy-fifth Anniversary of the World Health Organization as well as for the Sixtieth Anniversary of the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR), which were both issued in April 2023.
