



UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE - TÜRKIYE

Heritage is our legacy from the past, what we live with today, and what we pass on to future generations. Our cultural and natural heritage are both irreplaceable sources of life and inspiration.

The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) seeks to encourage the identification, protection and preservation of cultural and natural heritage around the world considered to be of outstanding value to humanity. This is embodied in an international treaty called the Convention Concerning the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage, adopted by UNESCO in 1972.

For over 25 years, the United Nations Postal Administration has issued stamps featuring UNESCO World Heritage sites. For the 2023 series, UNPA features six sites in Türkiye.

After a devastating earthquake struck Syria and Türkiye earlier in the year, the United Nations pledged its support and assistance to these countries. UNPA hopes that these stamps will bring awareness to the importance of the protection and preservation of these beautiful sites, in addition to showing its solidarity to the country and people of Türkiye.



The United Nations recognizes World Mental Health Day each year on 10 October, to raise awareness about the importance of mental health and to support those living with mental health conditions. The theme for 2023 is "Mental Health is a Universal Human Right".

Mental health is an integral part of our general health and well-being, as well as a basic human right. Having good mental health means we are better able to connect, function, cope, and thrive. However, people living with mental health conditions often experience human rights violations, discrimination, and stigma. The result is that millions of people around the world suffer in silence and are greatly affected in their daily lives.

The World Health Organization (WHO) estimates that 1 in 8 people across the world live with a mental health condition. Despite being prevalent in countries around the world, most societies neglect mental health and do not provide the care and support people need and deserve. While mental health conditions can be effectively treated at a relatively low cost, the gap between people needing care and those with access to care remains substantial and effective treatment coverage remains extremely low.

World Mental Health Day is an opportunity to strengthen our shared commitment in making mental health a priority. We work towards making everyone able to exercise their human rights and access affordable, quality mental health care and where people can participate fully in society, free from stigma and discrimination.



UNPA also issues a souvenir card for the World Mental Health Day stamp issue, which carries a statement by António Guterres, Secretary-General of the United Nations and Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, Director-General of the World Health Organization.

A quantity of 7,500 cards was printed.

The souvenir card is available in either mint or cancelled condition.



MARIE CURIE GENEVA DEFINITIVE STAMP

On 7 November 2023, UNPA issues a CHF 2,30 stamp to honour Marie Curie. The quote on the stamp, which is in French, reads as follows:

"Nothing in life is to be feared, it is only to be understood"

The CHF 2,30 stamp is part of a definitive stamp series illustrated by Martin Mörck (Norway).

Marie Curie is best known for her pioneering research in radioactivity and her discovery of two elements, polonium and radium. She was the first woman to win a Nobel Prize, the first person to win a Nobel Prize twice, and the only person to win a Nobel Prize in two scientific fields.

Born Marya Skłodowska in Warsaw, Poland on November 7, 1867, she was the youngest of five children. Despite her family's poverty and limited access to scientific education, combined with the fact that she was a woman, Marie overcame many obstacles to pursue her passion and her scientific career.





In 1891, she went to Paris to study physics and mathematics at the Sorbonne. It was there she met Pierre Curie, professor at the School of Physics, where they worked together studying radioactivity and researching. They were married in 1895.

In 1903, Marie and Pierre Curie were awarded the Nobel Prize for Physics, jointly with Henri Becquerel, for their combined, though separate work on radioactivity, a term Curie coined herself. In the same year, Marie passed her doctorate thesis in Physics. After her husband's death in 1906, she took over his professorship at Sorbonne, becoming the institution's first female professor.

In 1911, Marie Curie earned a second Nobel Prize in chemistry (along with her husband) for her discovery of two new elements: polonium (named after her homeland) and radium.

Marie Curie's research laid the foundation for modern nuclear science, from X-rays to radiotherapy for treating cancer. She stood out not only for her brilliant talent and dedication, but also for inspiring woman and girls in science.
