## UNPA WINS STAMP AWARDS!

The Universal Postal Union (UPU) has informed the United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA) that it was awarded the Silver Medal for group C of the 19th competition class of the 2024 Universal Postal Union (UPU) International Stamp Exhibition.

UNPA submitted 16 pages of selected United Nations stamps that were issued between 2021 and 2024 for the competition. The UPU competition class criteria focus primarily on the quality of philatelic items submitted by participating postal services, assessing aspects like design, technical execution, theme relevance, creativity and overall presentation.

The criteria for the competition were based upon theme adherence, design quality, technical execution, creativity, overall presentation and compliance with UPU standards.

UNPA was also honoured the Best Exhibitor of the China 2024 Asian International Stamp Exhibition and also the Best Exhibition by the China International Fair for Trade in Services at the China 2024 Asian International Stamp Exhibition last year.

# 2025 LUNAR CALENDAR – YEAR OF THE SNAKE

## NEW YORK SPECIAL EVENT SHEET – \$1.65

On 17 January 2025, UNPA celebrates the lunar new year with the issuance of a special event sheet of 10 stamps, 2025 Lunar Calendar – Year of the Snake. The lunar new year officially begins on 29 January 2025 and continues until 16 February 2026.

The 10 \$1.65 denominated stamps and background design show four snakes intimately embracing and coiling around each other. In Chinese culture, the circular connection of head to tail signifies endless continuity. The vibrant red colour represents the exuberance and energy of life, ever-renewing. The snakes' united embrace, reminiscent of a Chinese knot and the folk game "jumping the four directions", adds a playful touch while staying true to the times. Each uniquely patterned snake intertwines to represent the vibrant diversity of the world's nations, united in harmony. With their minimalistic lines, peace lilies are gently sketched, underscoring the message of unity, friendship and peaceful coexistence.

The tabs to the left of the stamps show the United Nations logo on a gold background.

The stamps and the background design were illustrated by Tiger Pan (China). Mr. Pan also illustrated the United Nations Lunar Calendar

series for the 2018 Year of the Dog, 2022 Year of the Tiger, 2023 Year of the Rabbit and 2024 Year of the Dragon.

UNPA will also offer a Year of the Snake postcard and a first day cover with the same design as the stamps.

The stamp sheets may be personalized with a photograph to replace the United Nations logo. Customers can visit the UNPA stamp shops in New York, Geneva or Vienna to have their photos taken in person. They can also upload their photos directly to the UNPA website: [unstamps.org/personalizedstamps](https://unstamps.org/personalizedstamps). Ordering instructions are available on the website.

Customers with standing order requirements for special event sheets will automatically receive the stamp sheets through their accounts. Customers with standing order requirements for miscellaneous products will automatically receive the postcard and a set of one single and one combo first day cover through their accounts. # INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY 2025

## FOR ALL WOMEN AND GIRLS: RIGHTS. EQUALITY. EMPOWERMENT

On 8 March 2025, UNPA will celebrate International Women's Day with the issuance of six stamps and a souvenir card.

This year's theme "For ALL Women and Girls: Rights. Equality. Empowerment." calls for action that can unlock equal rights, power and opportunities for all, and a feminist future where no one is left behind. Central to this vision is empowering the next generation – youth, particularly young women and adolescent girls – as catalysts for lasting change.

The year 2025 is a pivotal moment in the global pursuit of gender equality and women's empowerment, as it marks the thirtieth anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action. Adopted at the Fourth World Conference on Women in 1995 in Beijing, by 189 governments, the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action remain the most progressive and widely endorsed blueprint for women's and girls' rights worldwide. The Platform guides policies, programmes and investment that impact critical areas of our lives, such as education, health, peace, media, political participation, economic empowerment and the elimination of violence against women and girls. Addressing these issues, along with emerging priorities around climate justice and the power of digital technologies, is urgent, with just five years left to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals.

Under the banner of UN Women's global campaign to mark the thirtieth anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, "For ALL Women and Girls", this year's International Women's Day is a rallying cry to take action in three key areas:

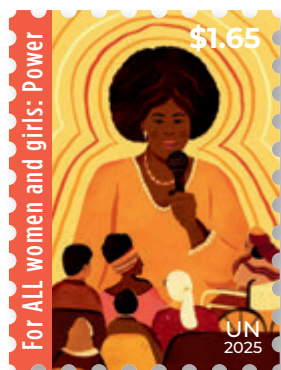
1. Advance women's and girls' rights. Fight relentlessly for women's and girls' full range of human rights, challenging all forms of violence, discrimination and exploitation.
2. Promote gender equality. Address systemic barriers, dismantle patriarchy, transform entrenched inequities and elevate the voices of marginalized women and girls, including young people, to ensure inclusivity and empowerment.
3. Foster empowerment. Redefine power structures by ensuring inclusive access to education, employment, leadership and decision-making spaces. Prioritize opportunities for young women and girls to lead and innovate.

# INTERNATIONAL DAY OF SPORT FOR DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

On 6 April 2025, UNPA will issue six new stamps and three souvenir sheets to commemorate the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace.

Recognized by the General Assembly and celebrated annually on 6 April, the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace recognizes the positive role sport and physical activity play in communities and in people's lives across the globe.

The United Nations has long recognized the power and universality of sport, using it to unite individuals and groups through supporting sport for development efforts, participating in events globally, and developing its own sports-related campaigns and initiatives.

The theme for 2025 is "Leveling the Playing Field: Sport for Social Inclusion". In the lead-up to the Second World Summit for Social Development in 2025, the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace 2025 will focus on "social inclusion", with a focus on the most marginalized groups, as well as on age, gender and race. This year's theme aims to challenge stereotypes, promote equal opportunities and enable inclusive sport for all, regardless of age, gender or race. It highlights the role of sport as a unifying force that fosters inclusion and more equitable societies, while being a powerful platform for dialogue to tackle prejudices and inspire positive change across the world.

In commemoration of International Day of Sport for Development and Peace, an event will be hosted at United Nations Headquarters

in New York, in collaboration with the Permanent Mission of the Principality of Monaco, Permanent Mission of the State of Qatar, the Department of Economic and Social Affairs, the Department of Global Communications and UN Women. The event will be an opportunity to engage in meaningful discussions on the intersecting issues of sport, gender equality, healthy aging and racial equality.

Owing to its vast reach, unparalleled popularity and foundation of positive values, sport continues to contribute towards the United Nations' objectives for the advancement of human rights, social and economic development and peace.

The three souvenir sheets feature a statement by Secretary-General António Guterres in English, French and German. The text reads in English as follows:

*"Sport has a unique and transformative power. It transcends borders and unites people, fosters teamwork and resilience, and promotes a spirit of inclusion. Each of these values is essential to the work of the United Nations, and for shaping a more healthy, sustainable and peaceful world for all."*

## EXPO 2025 – OSAKA, JAPAN – SPECIAL EVENT MINI-SHEET

The United Nations will take part in the 2025 World Exposition (Expo 2025) in Osaka, Kansai, Japan, from 13 April to 13 October 2025. With the theme “United for a Better Future,” the UN Pavilion will highlight the organization’s 80 years of efforts in tackling global challenges and crises, while urging collective action to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals through multilateral cooperation. The pavilion will host exhibits and programming of 35 United Nations entities and 15 United Nations departments and offices of the Secretariat.

The UN Pavilion’s logo features a white dove motif carrying an olive branch with leaves reflecting the colours of the Sustainable Development Goals. The logo embodies the United Nations commitment to peace and security as essential elements in achieving the Goals and a world in which everyone thrives in peace, equality and dignity on a healthy planet.

The overall theme of Expo 2025 Osaka Kansai is “Designing Future Society for Our Lives”, with sub-themes “Saving Lives”, “Empowering Lives”, “Connecting Lives”. Approximately 28 million visitors are expected to attend.

To commemorate the United Nations participation at Expo 2025, UNPA will issue a three-stamp mini-sheet in the denominations of \$1.65, CHF 2,50 and €1,90 which feature images of the UN Pavilion at Expo 2025 Osaka Kansai.
