ONE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PALACE MUSEUM NEW YORK SPECIAL EVENT SHEET - \$1.65



Item No. 394.5942

On 18 May 2025, the United Nations Postal Administration commemorates International Museum Day and the one hundredth anniversary of the Palace Museum with the issuance of a New York special event sheet. The 10 stamps in the denomination of \$1.65 highlight the cultural and historical value of the Palace Museum as a World Cultural Heritage site and convey the unique charm of Chinese traditional culture to the world.

The Palace Museum, housed in the Forbidden City in the heart of Beijing, China, was founded on 10 October 1925. It is built on the site of the Ming and Qing dynasties imperial palaces. In 1987, the Forbidden City was listed as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site

The stamp sheet features floral motifs selected from 10 cultural relics of the Museum's collection. Each flower – such as the magnolia, peony, plum blossom and lotus – has deep cultural meaning and celebrates the beauty of diversity and endless vitality.

The designs, left column, from top to bottom

- Flower and bird album: crabapple blossom, Yu Zhi, Qing Dynasty (1644–1911)
- 2. Black lacquer bed with mother-of-pearl inlay of flower and bird patterns, Ming Dynasty (1368–1644)
- Jewel-inlaid gold cup with the inscription "Everlasting Territory", Qianlong reign, Qing Dynasty (1644–1911)

- 4. Treasure bonsai in gold pot, Qing Dynasty (1644-1911)
- 5. Painted enamel stem plate with flower, fruit and vine design, Qing Dynasty (1644–1911)

The designs, right column, top to bottom

- Green satin flower goddess costume, embroidered with osmanthus, rabbit and round flowers from patterns, Qing Dynasty (1644–1911)
- 7. Enamel painted yellow-glazed bowl with orchid and rock design, Yongzheng reign, Qing Dynasty (1644–1911)
- 8. Carved red lacquer dish with narcissus, Yuan Dynasty (1279-1368)
- Birchwood box with multi-gem inlays symbolizing "Jade Hall Wealth and Nobility", Ming Dynasty (1368–1644)
- 10. Glazed tiles from the screen wall inside the Gate of Observing Righteousness, Hall of Mental Cultivation

INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF GLACIERS' PRESERVATION VIENNA SPECIAL EVENT SHEET

To highlight the importance of glacier preservation, UNPA issues a special event sheet of 10 stamps in the denomination of €1,20 on 6 June 2025.

The General Assembly proclaimed 2025 as the International Year of Glaciers' Preservation to raise awareness on the vital role glaciers, snow and ice play in the climate system and water cycle, as well as the far-reaching impacts of rapid glacial melt.

Glaciers are crucial for regulating the global climate and providing freshwater for billions of people. However, due to climate change, driven mainly by human activities, these vital resources are rapidly melting.

The preservation of glaciers stands as one of humanity's most urgent challenges. These ancient ice formations are not just frozen water – they are the guardians of our planet's climate history, the source of life for billions, and sacred places for many cultures. Their rapid disappearance is a stark reminder that we must act now.

The designs on the sheet feature the following:

- 1. The Perito Moreno Glacier, Argentina
- Mount Gongga and glacier in Hailuogou Glacier Forest Park, China
- Alaska glaciers scenic view from Prince William Sound bay, United States
- 4. Pasterze Glacier, Austria
- 5. Franz Josef Glacier, New Zealand

Right column, top to bottom:

- Jökulsárlón Galcier Lagoon with glaciers and mountains of Vatnajökull, Iceland
- 2. Icy waters and Lambert Glacier, Antarctica
- 3. Aletsch Glacier, Switzerland
- 4. Jostedalsbreen National Park, Norway
- 5. Towering great icebergs in the Ilulissat Icefjord, Greenland

The background of the sheet features Ilulissat glaciers in Disko Bay, Greenland.

The sheet was designed by Rorie Katz (United Nations).

2025 ENDANGERED SPECIES

On 25 April 2025 the United Nations Postal Administration continues its Endangered Species stamp series with the issuance of twelve stamps, three maximum cards, a limited-edition silk cover and the 2025 Endangered Species folder.

For 34 years, UNPA has issued stamps in support of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) to raise awareness of the multitude of benefits that conservation provides to people.

This year's Endangered Species stamps series highlights a remarkable collection of animal and plant species across various taxonomic groups and ecosystems facing diverse wildlife conservation challenges.

The 2025 series also celebrates the thirtieth anniversary of the Agreement on the Conservation of African-Eurasian Migratory Waterbirds (AEWA), featuring the white-headed duck, the African penguin and the grey-crowned crane, which are listed both in the CITES appendices and the AEWA species list. This collaboration emphasizes the importance of multilateral environmental agreements working in complementarity with each other to achieve shared global biodiversity goals








ENDANGERED SPECIES FOLDER

NO NUKES

The United Nations is commemorating the eightieth anniversary of the atomic bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan, which took place on 6 and 9 August 1945, respectively. As we reflect on the devastation caused by nuclear weapons, this anniversary serves as a powerful reminder of the urgent need for global disarmament and the prevention of future nuclear conflict.

The United Nations has long supported efforts to eliminate nuclear weapons through various treaties, resolutions and international cooperation. Its key initiatives include the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons and the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.

Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons

This treaty, which entered into force in 1970, aims to prevent the spread of nuclear weapons and technology, and to promote cooperation in the peaceful uses of nuclear energy. It also seeks to advance the goal of nuclear disarmament.

Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons

This treaty, which entered into force in 2021, establishes the first legal framework specifically aimed at eliminating nuclear weapons. It prohibits the development, testing, production, acquisition and use of nuclear weapons.

The United Nations also promotes disarmament through other initiatives, including the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty, and the Partial Test Ban Treaty. These treaties further contribute to the broader goals of the United Nations in preventing the spread of nuclear weapons and promoting nuclear disarmament.

On this anniversary, the United Nations message to the world is to remember the lessons of these tragic events and recommit to a world free from nuclear weapons, emphasizing the importance of multilateralism, sustainable development and peace.


