Dear Collector,

As 2025 comes to a close, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support of the United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA). As we celebrate the eightieth anniversary of the United Nations this year, we can look back and say that we have accomplished a lot.

UNPA started the 2025 programme with its very popular Lunar Calendar series – featuring the “Year of the Snake”. In March, UNPA issued stamps for International Women’s Day under the theme “For All Women and Girls”. In April, stamps were issued to commemorate the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace. UNPA also continued its long-running stamps series on Endangered Species.


In May and June, UNPA released sold-out stamps celebrating the one hundredth anniversary of the Palace Museum in Beijing, followed by the International Year of Glaciers’ Preservation. In August, UNPA issued stamps promoting “No Nukes” in commemoration of the eightieth anniversary of the Hiroshima and Nagasaki atomic bombings.

In September, for the International Day of Peace, UNPA is issuing special embroidered “Dove of Peace” stamps in conjunction with the Universal Postal Union and 10 other postal administrations. In October, UNPA is commemorating the eightieth anniversary of the United Nations with three special stamp sheets designed internally by a colleague from the Department of Global Communications. In November, UNPA will issue its World Heritage stamp series featuring sites from Mexico, along with the annual collection folders.

As we close out this special year honouring the 80th Anniversary of the UN, let us all reflect on what Peace means to each and every one of us and how we can contribute personally to the enduring, universal value of peace around the world.

We look forward to another successful year in 2026 with many new and exciting stamp themes.

As always, we value your support of our philatelic programme.

UNITED FOR PEACE – ONE STITCH AT A TIME

In September 2025, the United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA) in conjunction with the Universal Postal Union (UPU) and 10 other postal organizations jointly issued embroidered “Dove of Peace” stamps to celebrate the International Day of Peace and promote the value of peace to people all around the world.

It is very rare for the UPU and postal organizations to jointly issue stamps to promote peace. In addition to UNPA, the other postal organizations are Åland (Finland), Armenia, Austria, Barbados, Cyprus, Faroe Islands (Denmark), Greenland (Denmark), Liechtenstein, Luxembourg and Switzerland.


The “Dove of Peace” stamp features an embroidered white dove carrying an olive branch outlined in blue, symbolizing a shared commitment to promoting peace. The peace dove glides forward with outstretched wings speaking a language that knows no borders, no religions and no ideologies. The project transcends borders just like real doves, acting as unique postage ambassadors unifying people from around the world, carrying a global message of peace.

This limited-edition stamp crafted from textiles was embroidered and manufactured by the Austrian company Hämmerle & Vogel. While seemingly simple, it involves skilful craftsmanship. It is both practical and artistic, combining a great design with a powerful message.

The “Dove of Peace” stamp is not just a philatelic product. It is a collective appeal for hope and unity and a symbol of peace across continents connecting postal administrations and people around the world. We can all contribute personally by reflecting on what peace means to each and every one of us, and how we can contribute to this global movement of peace.

The UPU and UNPA invite you to join this movement by using this stamp as a universal medium to symbolize and encourage the unity of peace across nations, one stitch at a time.



BUILDING OUR FUTURE TOGETHER


On 24 October 2025, the United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA) celebrated the 80th anniversary of the United Nations with the issuance of three stamp sheets. In 2025, the United Nations marks its 80th anniversary, celebrating eight decades of promoting peace, human rights, social progress, and sustainable development. The theme focuses on "Building our Future Together" emphasizing the need for collective action to address global issues.

The three stamp sheets in the denominations of \$1.70, CHF 1,70 and €2,10 feature four stamps in a vertical design. The designs incorporate the themes of the pillars of the United Nations: peace and security, development and human rights.


The first stamp on the top is Earth portrayed as greenery, showing growth. The second stamp focuses on human rights – the peace dove and hand represent humanity joined in the common goal of tolerance, acceptance and love. The third stamp shows an architectural rainbow that integrates with a peace dove, protecting the growing foliage which allows for growth and development. The last stamp on the bottom shows the freedom of a butterfly, a symbol of transformation and hope.

The stamp issue was a team effort between the Graphic Design Unit (GDU) of the Department of Global Communications of the United Nations and the UNPA.







UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE – MEXICO


The World Heritage Convention, adopted by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in 1972, emphasizes the collective responsibility of all nations to protect these sites for present and future generations.

World heritage refers to cultural and natural sites of “outstanding universal value” that are recognized by UNESCO as needing protection for the benefit of all humanity. These sites, inscribed on the World Heritage List, represent a shared legacy and are considered to be of exceptional importance to the planet’s cultural and natural heritage.





On 10 December 2025, the UN Postal Administration will issue a special event sheet of 10 stamps in the denomination of \$1.70 to honour Member states who joined the United Nations 70 years ago.

In 1955, 16 countries joined the United Nations, marking the largest enlargement in the Organization's history, bringing the total number of Member States from 60 to 76.

This special stamp sheet commemorates the 70th anniversary of the membership of Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Finland, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Jordan, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Libya, Nepal, Portugal, Romania, Spain and Sri Lanka.

The stamp sheet highlights the continued **engagement** of these **M**ember states in the work and principles of the United Nations.

The \$1.70 stamp design shows the United Nations emblem in white on a blue background.

The stamp tabs were designed by João Varela (Portugal). The artist wanted the design to celebrate the 70th anniversary of the 1955 UN admissions by showing many nations coming together. He created the number "70" out of interlocking rings, using colors drawn from the sixteen national flags that blend into gradients instead of strict borders. The deep UN blue background ties it to the organization's identity, and the two-letter country codes give each member equal space and a clear voice in the design.

The background of the sheet displays the flags of the sixteen countries who joined the United Nations in 1955.

Customers can visit the UNPA stamp shops in New York, Geneva, or Vienna **to**, or visit UNPA website [unstamps.org/personalized](https://unpa.org/unstamps.org/personalized) **stamps** to purchase this new special event sheet. Customers with standing orders for New York special event sheets will automatically receive this item through their accounts. The imprint on the white card features people practicing traditional water jousting in the foreground, with the city of Ulm in the background. Water jousting is still among Ulm's most well-known traditions.

The show cachet features the UN aside a lightbulb with a representation of atoms in motion inside, a nod to Albert Einstein who was born in Ulm.

Both were designed by the Austrian artist Prof. Hannes Margreiter.

The white card imprint shows a view of the landmark cathedral Notre Dame, which reopened this year.

The show cachet features a gargoyle along the UN emblem and the Salon Philatélique logo.

The blue card imprint illustrates Isotta Nogarola (1418-1466), a writer and intellectual born in Verona, who is considered the first major female humanist and one of the most important humanists of the Italian Renaissance.

The show cachet represents the emblem of the United Nations, alongside those of Veronafil and the Happy Human symbol. The Happy Human is the international symbol of Humanism.

Both were designed by the Austrian artist Prof. Hannes Margreiter.
