70 YEARS OF MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

New York Special Event Sheet

On 10 December 2025, the United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA) issued a special event sheet of 10 stamps in the denomination of \$1.70 to honour Member States who joined the United Nations 70 years ago.

In 1955, 16 countries joined the United Nations, marking the Organization's largest increase in its history, bringing the total number of Member States from 60 to 76.

This special stamp sheet commemorates the seventieth anniversary of the membership of Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Finland, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Jordan, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Libya, Nepal, Portugal, Romania, Spain and Sri Lanka. The stamp sheet highlights the continued engagement of these Member States in the work and principles of the United Nations.

The \$1.70 stamp design shows the United Nations emblem in white on a blue background. The background of the sheet displays the flags of the 16 countries who joined the United Nations in 1955.

The stamp tabs were designed by João Varela (Portugal). The artist wanted the design to celebrate the seventieth anniversary of the 1955 admissions to the United Nations by showing many nations coming together. He created the number "70" out of interlocking rings, using colours drawn from the 16 national flags that blend into gradients rather than strict borders. The blue background ties it to the Organization's identity, and the two-letter country codes give each Member State equal space and a clear voice in the design.

80 YEARS OF THE JOURNAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

New York Special Event Sheet


On 12 January 2026, UNPA issued a special event sheet of 10 stamps to commemorate the eightieth anniversary of the issuance of the first *Journal of the United Nations*. The stamp sheet in the denomination of \$1.70, pays tribute to the *Journal's* enduring role as an official repository of the United Nations past seen through the lens of its daily meetings and activities.

The first edition of the *Journal* was issued on 10 January 1946, the same day that the General Assembly convened its first session. This stamp issuance celebrates eight decades of this landmark publication, which has chronicled the evolution of multilateralism while maintaining accessibility to the Organization's work.

Serving as the United Nations daily programme of official meetings and other activities, the *Journal* has faithfully documented the trajectory of international diplomacy, providing delegates, staff and the public with a transparent, multilingual and authoritative source of information. Documenting history as it has unfolded, from the Organization's early years until today, the *Journal* has ensured that every official meeting remains part of the institutional memory of the United Nations.

The stamps and tabs feature delegates, dignitaries and staff reading the *Journal*, alongside images of the publication in multiple languages across the decades.

This anniversary offers a moment to reflect on the *Journal's* pivotal role in preserving the legacy of the United Nations while continuously

adapting to the demands of a digitally interconnected world. In an era of rapid information exchange, its commitment to accuracy, accessibility and multilingualism remains as crucial as ever.

2026 LUNAR CALENDAR – YEAR OF THE HORSE

NEW YORK SPECIAL EVENT SHEET

On 16 January 2026, UNPA celebrates the Lunar New Year with the issuance of a special event sheet of 10 stamps in the denomination of \$1.70 for the Year of the Horse. The Lunar New Year officially begins on 17 February 2026 and continues until 5 February 2027.

The horse represents independence, perseverance and ambition. During this year, decisive action and resilience are encouraged while embracing new opportunities, making it a time to pursue goals with confidence and determination. Full of optimism and drive, 2026 promises growth, success and good fortune for all who harness its dynamic energy.

The design draws its inspiration from the Eastern Han Dynasty bronze artwork "Horse Treading on a Flying Swallow." The horse is depicted with its forehooves raised mid-air and hind legs firmly planted, embodying a beauty of power that harmonizes dynamic motion and static balance.

The tabs to the left of the stamps show the United Nations logo on a gold background.

The stamps and the background design were illustrated by Tiger Pan (China). Mr. Pan also illustrated the United Nations Lunar Calendar

series for the 2018 Year of the Dog, 2022 Year of the Tiger, 2023 Year of the Rabbit, 2024 Year of the Dragon and 2025 Year of the Snake.

UNPA will also offer a Year of the Horse postcard and a first day cover, with the same design as the stamps.

The stamp sheets may be personalized with a photograph to replace the United Nations logo. Customers can visit the UNPA stamp shops in New York, Geneva or Vienna to have their photos taken in person or they can upload their photos directly to the UNPA website with ordering instructions: unstamps.org/personalized-stamps.



ECOSOC

New York Definitive

On 23 January, UNPA will issue a \$3.15 definitive stamp to mark the eightieth anniversary of the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC).

Established in 1945 by the Charter of the United Nations, ECOSOC held its first meeting on 23 January 1946. Its mandate – to coordinate the economic, social and cultural activities of the United Nations and promote international cooperation and development – has placed it at the heart of advancing the principles of the Charter. Multilateralism, inclusivity and global solidarity have been central to ECOSOC’s mission from the outset.

For eight decades, ECOSOC has provided a unique platform where Member States, the United Nations system, civil society and other stakeholders come together to address the world’s most pressing challenges. From post-war recovery and decolonization to climate change, inequality and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, ECOSOC has helped guide international responses and foster collective action for a more just, sustainable and peaceful world.

The artwork on the stamp was created by Brazilian street artist Eduardo Kobra.

Mr. Kobra painted a large mural for the United Nations in September 2022, which was displayed at United Nations Headquarters, depicting a father handing the Earth to his daughter, symbolizing sustainable development and intergenerational responsibility for the planet, aligning with United Nations goals for climate action and peace.

This temporary installation celebrated Brazil’s independence and brought street art to the United Nations, with Kobra’s work featuring vibrant colours and universal themes like human rights and environmental care.





INTERNATIONAL DAY OF FORESTS

The General Assembly proclaimed 21 March as the International Day of Forests, to be celebrated annually to raise awareness of the importance of all types of forests. Each year a theme is chosen by the Collaborative Partnership on Forests.

The theme for 2026 is "Forests and economies", which celebrates the essential roles of forests in driving economic prosperity. These roles go well beyond income and jobs from forest production and the trade of renewable raw materials and foods; forests also sustain family and community agriculture, enhance agricultural productivity and safeguard healthy watersheds.

With many countries seeking to move toward a sustainable bioeconomy, forest products offer nature-based solutions as replacements for carbon-intensive materials while generating new economic opportunities.

Forests are indispensable for healthy economies – today and for future generations.

Countries and people around the world are encouraged to undertake local, national and international efforts to organize activities involving forests and trees, such as tree-planting campaigns.

THE DESIGNS

\$1.70 – Forests drive sustainable development by providing livelihoods and income for communities while supporting biodiversity. They supply food, clean air and fresh water and play a vital role in regulating climate by storing carbon. Healthy forests strengthen resilience, reduce poverty and ensure long-term environmental and economic stability.

CHF 1,90 – Forests support jobs and act as engines of economic growth by sustaining industries such as forestry, agriculture, ecotourism and non-timber forest products. They are essential sources of medicine, food security and nutrition, especially for rural and Indigenous communities. By supporting millions of livelihoods worldwide, forests strengthen local economies while promoting long-term resilience.

€1,45 – Forests drive sustainable development by providing livelihoods for millions of people through forestry, agriculture and forest-based industries. They support local economies while maintaining ecosystems that communities depend on for daily life. When managed sustainably, forests help reduce poverty and ensure long-term environmental and economic resilience.
